Deadlines for applications - Charitable grants for those injured or bereaved at Grenfell Tower or one of the terror attacks in London

London Emergencies Trust is a charity set up to get public donations to those injured or bereaved by the fire at Grenfell Tower, or one of the four terrorist attacks in London this year.

The Trust will wind down its operations in Spring 2018, and will by then have have distributed over 10m to hundreds of people.

You may be able to apply for a charitable grant because you were injured and hospitalised, or lost a loved one.

We need to hear from anyone who hasn't approached us for help by these dates because – as an emergency response charity – LET was always intended to be active for a limited time only and to get donations to people caught up in these emergencies as quickly as possible, and then to 'stand down' (unless or until there is another emergency we are asked to help with).
